In line with recommendations in Lifesavers Child Protection Policy the promoters of this event request that any person wishing to engage in any form of Video or Photography (including mobile phone technology) should register their name and address with the event organiser (Broadway and Failsworth Life Saving Club) before carrying out any such photography.

The promoter reserves the right of entry to this event and reserves the right to decline entry to any person who is unable to meet or abide by the promoters conditions. Please mention the above requirements to parents, family and friends who may be attending the sessions.

- It is imperative that all session begin promptly. Please arrive on time.
- **Do not turn up early for Debdale; 9.30am is the time you should arrive.**
- A small number of wetsuits (for the younger members) can be borrowed for the open water seasons only, for an **non-refundable** charge of £5.00, from the club on a first come first served basis
- Do not enter the water unless instructed by your trainer/examiner
- Appropriate clothing must be brought for each session (i.e. Wetsuit/yellow t-shirt/quartered hat)
- Suitable footwear must be worn at all times
- Please notify the club if you (or family) intend to use a camera or video (see above)
- NOTE – **A minimum of 5 Open Water sessions** (all sessions must be attended for Beach Lifeguard) must be completed for any award plus theory to equal the total number of training hours required.
- Assistant Beach and Beach Lifeguards Awards -these will only be awarded at the end of the open water (season) to the candidates with the required number of training/open water attendance hours, including theory.
- Please book early, as under the recommendation of the risk assessment, numbers will be limited.
- Risk Assessment– please do not turn up on the day as place numbers are limited and strictly for applicants only
- Please make sure that all information required is complete as incomplete booking forms will be rejected.
- The above criteria will be adhered to for your safety
