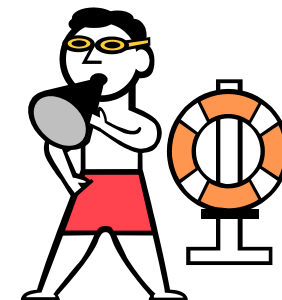

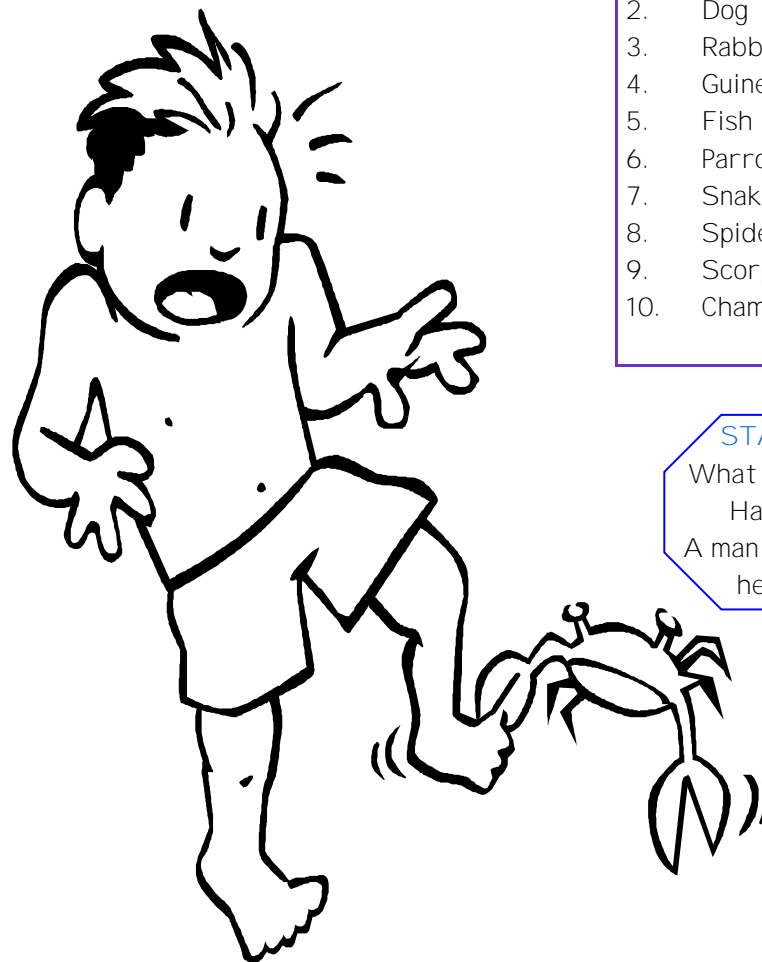

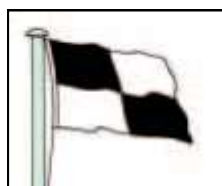
Please note: No-one should enter the water until instructed to do so. Thank you

Wet shoes are available from Wynsors or any large shoe stores.



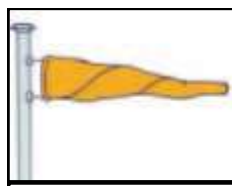
Red and yellow flags mark areas of water that are patrolled by lifeguards. These are the safest places to swim



When you see black and white chequered flags, it means an area of water has been marked for use by craft. For your own safety, do not swim in these



The red flag indicates danger. Never enter the water when the red flag is flying



An orange windsock flying at the beach indicates that wind conditions are especially dangerous – so under no circumstances should you take an inflatable into the sea

News From Danny

OPEN WATER 2009—Planning started after receiving the tides in November 2008 and started in earnest in March to plan the Open Water Events. All involved had a meeting at the Boat and Horses in Chadderton, Broadway and Failsworth LSC, Droylsden LSC, Fleetwood LSC, Altrincham LSC and Blackpool Canoe club.

This is the first time we have all got together before the open waters. As we set out are lesson plans and who would take each award, we built on **experience and dedication of each individual's role so everyone knew what they were doing.** This was not going to be a suck it and see programme and over the Summer months we achieved these awards:-

- 13 Rookie Beach Awards
- 4 Rookie Ocean Sea Awareness Awards
- 4 Rookie Sea Awareness Awards
- 5 Assistant Beach Awards
- 5 Bronze Cross Awards
- 5 Silver Cross Awards
- 3 New Beach Lifeguards
- 5 Renewal Beach Lifeguards

So far through the joint collaboration we have exceeded all expectations. Reflecting back over the years, the events that have been staged at Fleetwood have enhanced beach use and made possible developments with local Organisations. The partnership between lifesaving clubs goes from strength to strength. We averaged 45 people per session, this is an outstanding year. I would like to thank all the Teachers and assessors, Young Lifesavers and Lifeguards and especially the members of the various life-saving clubs who help before, and after these events, without these dedicated helpers Open Water would not happen. Thank you for making 2009 Open water a great success. 2010 is NOW in Full swing.

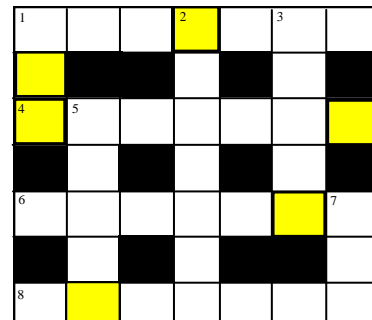
